



## Visit the Art Museum on the Ten Toe Express

**TOTAL WALK DISTANCE:** *Approximately .80 mile*

*For a great view of Forest Park, plus a chance to see a world class art collection for free, visit the St. Louis Art Museum!*

### Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Skinker Station. As you exit the station, Kayak's Coffee, a great place to stop for coffee or a light breakfast or lunch, is at the corner of Skinker and Forest Park Parkway.
- Depending on which way you exit the station, you will have to cross Forest Park Parkway or Skinker to reach the southeast corner of the intersection - the entrance to the park.

*Note: This is a heavily traveled intersection. Make sure drivers see you before you cross and that you observe the crossing signals.*

- Enter the park on Lagoon Drive and follow the road ahead southeast to Fine Arts Drive

### *Here is Where the Hard Part Starts:*

- The Museum is located on Art Hill and you have to walk up that hill to reach the Museum. But the trip is well worth the climb!
- At the top of Art Hill, take a few minutes to rest on the plaza in the shadow of Saint Louis before enjoying the museum.

*Remember, great lunches are served at the Museum Café!*

### *For an Added Challenge:*

- Take a walk to the Zoo to add another 0.25 miles!

### *Alternate Route:*

- Take MetroLink to the Forest Park Station. Exit at the west end of the station so you will be on the west side of DeBaliviere.
- Take the elevator or steps to the bus shelter at DeBaliviere. Catch the southbound #90 Hampton Bus which will take you to the front door of the Museum.
- For the return trip, walk down Art Hill to the Skinker MetroLink station.
