



Visit the Central Library Aboard the Ten Toe Express

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1 mile

Central Library is a magnificent building and a great resource for all St. Louisans. Take a stroll and explore the treasures of books and resources inside. One of many ways to get there is to walk from Civic Center MetroLink Station.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Civic Center Station.
- Exit the train and walk up the ramp (or the stairs if you wish) to Clark. You will have a great view of the mural on the Sheraton Hotel.
- Cross Clark in front of the Scottrade Center and walk north on 14th Street for 4 blocks to Olive. You will pass the Kiel Opera House on your left and the Soldiers' Memorial on your right.
- Cross Olive if you wish to enter the Library. There is a ground-floor entrance under the steps of the main entrance (public restrooms available).
- After leaving the library, walk east on Olive to 13th Street.
- Turn right on 13th Street, and walk 4 blocks south. Soldier's Memorial is now on your right and City Hall is straight ahead.
- Cross Market St. (There is no cross-walk at 13th Street so you may have to cross at 12th Street or 14th Street if there is traffic). The statue of Pierre Laclede marks a walkway alongside City Hall back to Clark.
- Turn right on Clark to return to the Scottrade Center and MetroLink.
