

## Ten Toes Express to Crown Candy Neighborhood

**TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: .85 mile**

*Crown Candy Confectionery has been a family business since 1913. The neighborhood around it has seen many people come and go – but everyone comes back for ice-cream! The Old North St. Louis Neighborhood Association is actively involved in the restoration and redevelopment of this historic area. (stop in on week-days for an up-date on the neighborhood's progress.)*

### Directions:

- Cross St. Louis Ave. to the former 14th Street Mall, where rebuilding is underway.
- Turn right and walk one block west to Blair.
- Turn left on Blair.
- Walk two blocks south on Blair to Warren then turn left. You will see the former Zion Lutheran church (1860) on your right.
- Walk one block east on Warren to 14th Street.
- Turn right on 14th Street. You will see the Marx Hardware store, a family business since 1875, ahead on your right.
- Continue one block south on 14th Street to North Market St.
- Turn left on North Market Street and head two blocks to view the new and restored houses.
- Cross North Market Street at Hadley to return on the other side of the street.
- Turn right on 13th Street to return to St. Louis Ave.
- Turn left on St. Louis to return to the bus-stop at 14th Street - after you enjoy a treat at Crown Candy, of course!
