

Ten Toes Express to Hanley House

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1 mile or less

Visit Clayton's rural past with a walk to Hanley House from Forsyth Station. This 8-room brick farmhouse, built in 1855, is preserved as a museum by the City of Clayton.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Forsyth Station
- Exit Metrolink and make your way to the north side of Forsyth. Washington University West Campus is ahead on your right.
- Walk west one block on Forsyth to Jackson and turn right, passing Ivey-Selkirk Auctioneers.
- Walk uphill on Jackson two blocks. Turn left on Westmoreland. Watch for the white picket fence of the Hanley House grounds on your left. (Call 290-8509 for public hours and group reservations.)
- Retrace your steps for a total distance of .75 miles.

OR:

- Continue west on Westmoreland to Hanley.
- Turn left on Hanley and turn left again on Maryland. Maryland is a cul-de-sac for motorists but not for pedestrians.
- Turn right on Lee, winding your way downhill to Forsyth. Turn left on Forsyth to return to MetroLink.
