



Visit the Heart of “The Hill” on the Ten Toe Express

Total Walk Distance: *1.5 miles or more*

The Italian-American community of “The Hill” is a proud neighborhood of small businesses within walking distance of homes. This walk offers tempting shopping and eating, with no hill to climb. The Fair Mercantile Building - a former department store adapted to restaurant, retail, and office use - has public restrooms.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to Central West End Station, then transfer to MetroBus #95 Kingshighway southbound.
- Exit the bus just after passing under I-44. Please watch your step there is no sidewalk here! (If you are using this stop for the first time, please tell your driver.)
- Walk one short block to Shaw Avenue and turn right.
- Walk three blocks west on Shaw to Marconi Avenue, then turn left toward St Ambrose. You may wish to view “The Immigrants”, a statue by St Louisan Rudy Torrini.
- Pass the church to turn right on Bischoff.
- Walk one block on Bischoff to Edwards and turn right to return to Shaw Ave.
- Retrace your steps on Shaw to Kingshighway

OR:

- Discover the rest of “The Hill” - a neighborhood divided but not destroyed by I-44.
- Turn left on Marconi (at Shaw Coffee) to face I-44. Follow Marconi to the fence, then follow the sidewalk on your left to reach the pedestrian bridge.
- Cross over I-44. Turn right to return to Marconi for one block.
- Turn right on Northrup. Walk three blocks east to return to Kingshighway.

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
