



## An Outing to the LaFayette Square Neighborhood on the Ten Toe Express

**TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1 mile**

*A visit by foot to the LaFayette Square neighborhood will allow you a good glimpse of the well-crafted details of the stunning Victorian restorations. While in the area, stop by LaFayette Park, found in the center of the neighborhood.*

### Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Civic Center, CWE, or Grand Station.
- Board MetroBus # 13.
- Exit the bus on Park Avenue at Benton Place, which lands you about halfway along the north side of LaFayette Park.
- Walk a square mile around the block. Head east on Park Avenue, keeping the houses on your right and the park on your left.
- Turn left on Missouri.
- Take another left on to LaFayette for one block.
- Turn left onto Mississippi and follow it around the park.
- Turn left at Park Avenue to return to your starting place at Benton Place.

### Alternate Route:

- If you would like to see more houses, a walk into Benton Place - an unusual oval street - will add another .25 mile. For an added challenge, a walk in LaFayette Park could easily add another half-mile or more, or you may wish to walk east on Park Avenue for refreshments.

*Don't forget to check out some of the new restaurants on Park Avenue for breakfast, lunch or dinner.*
