

A Ten Toes Express Trip to the Riverfront

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1 mile

The St. Louis Riverfront is easily reached from the Laclede's Landing MetroLink Station. There is much history to be explored, interesting sites to see, and places to stop for lunch or dinner. Enjoy the beginnings of St. Louis along the cobblestones near the water.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Laclede's Landing Station.
- Exit the platform from the west end elevator or the east end stairs.
- Walk downhill on Washington alongside the Eads Bridge to the river.
- Cross over Leonor K. Sullivan Blvd. for a look at Harry Weber's Lewis & Clark statue, "The Captains' Return". Turn right on Leonor K. Sullivan and walk south until you are centered under the Arch.
- Return to MetroLink.

For an Added Challenge:

- Add .66 miles if you continue on Leonor K. Sullivan to the Poplar St. Bridge and back.

OR:

- Add 1.33 miles if you continue on Leonor K. Sullivan to the Graffiti Wall and back. Keep the Mississippi River on your left until you pass under the railroad bridge, then walk through the break in the flood wall and look to your left to see the art on Graffiti Wall.

OR:

- Give yourself a gold star for climbing up the steps to the Arch!
